What To Do If You Are Homeless

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

If you are homeless it is your responsibility to contact every appropriate shelter on the list provided here to see if there is an opening. (If you are single, do not contact family shelters, etc.) If space is available you MUST accept it. If you refuse a space, the Town has no responsibility to assist you with other accommodations.

Call "211" and ask for Homeless Outreach. It is important to coordinate your efforts with this program as they may have additional resources for you.

If the shelters are full and you need Town assistance, please download our Welfare Application and follow those instructions. If you cannot download the forms, we can provide you with copies when you call our office.

If the shelters are full and you have nowhere to stay tonight <u>call</u> the Town Hall at 485-4747 and <u>let them know your situation</u>. You will receive a call back instructing you what to do.

When applying for assistance from the Town, please be prepared to provide the following verification:

- 1) Picture ID &/or Social Security Card for all members of your household
- 2) Addresses of where you were for the last 30 days (including names and phone numbers of people you stayed with)
- 3) Income and source of income for past 30 days. If working, copy of last paycheck
- 4) Bank statement for past 30 days and cash on hand
- 5) Parents and adult children names, addresses and phone numbers and are they able to assist you in any way.

You might be asked for more verification once you speak with the Welfare Director but those are the basic ones needed to process your application.
