5. Pine Trees at Entrance of Pembroke Hill Cemetery/Possible repaving the driveway
6. Finish stone wall repair at Pembroke Street Cemetery
7. Stake out plots in Pembroke Hill Cemetery
8. Gazebo in Evergreen Cemetery- to install new one similar to one in the 1950's plan.
